What is the role of the viola? What is its expression marking? What is the musical term for its behaviour
Movement III: key meter tempoform
Plot: what scene does this movement depict? How does the meter reinforce this?
What is the technical name for the behaviour of the bass line, and what does it represent?
<b>Extra-musical connections:</b> who was this work written for, as a part of Vivaldi's job? Why were the work's virtuosic elements important for its performers?
